# Friend of Glen Echo Park The Honorable Barbara A. Mikulski

U.S. Senator Barbara Mikulski has made a name for herself as a fighter, trailblazer and woman of action. A native of Baltimore, she was determined to make a difference in her community, first as a social worker and then as a community activist. She was elected to the Baltimore City Council in 1971 and later represented Maryland's 3rd District for 10 years in the U.S. House of Representatives. In 1986 she ran for U.S. Senate, becoming the first Democratic woman elected in her own right. Now dean of the female senators, Senator Mikulski serves as a mentor to other women in the Senate. As a member of the Senate Appropriations Committee, she has been instrumental in securing federal funds for Glen Echo Park and supported the creation of the Glen Echo Park Partnership for Arts and Culture from the start. Her dedication to the Park took on new meaning when, dressed in full tango regalia, she joined then Montgomery County Executive Douglas M. Duncan on the dance floor at the grand reopening of the Spanish Ballroom in 2003.

## Friend of Glen Echo Park The Honorable Brian E. Frosh

Maryland State Senator Brian Frosh's love of the arts goes back to his childhood, when he performed in an Adventure Theatre production of "Mr. Popper's Penguins." More recently, he has made a name for himself as a leader in the Maryland legislature. Senator Frosh was elected first to the Maryland House of Delegates in 1987 and then to the Maryland Senate in 1995. Throughout his career, Senator Frosh has lent his support to Glen Echo Park, making funding of the Park's renovations a personal priority. Considered the General Assembly's leading environmentalist, he has a special appreciation for the natural beauty of our region including the Potomac Palisades. Born in Washington, D.C., Frosh grew up in Montgomery County and is a graduate of Walter Johnson High School, Wesleyan University and Columbia University School of Law. He is married to Marcy Masters Frosh; they have two daughters.

# Organizational Achievement the Puppet Co. Allan Stevens and Christopher and MayField Piper, Founding Directors

If ever there was a Glen Echo Park institution, it is the Puppet Co. Now celebrating its 25th year in the Park, the Puppet Co.-like the Park itself-has shown remarkable growth over the past quarter century. The organization was founded by Christopher Piper and Allan Stevens, who felt that Glen Echo Park's fanciful architecture and natural beauty provided the perfect setting for a puppet company. They were joined by Mayfield Piper in 1987. After working for more than 20 years from various locations in the Park, in 2004, the group moved to their permanent home when the new state-of-the-art Puppet Co. Playhouse opened in the Arcade building. The Playhouse is the first indoor, yearround theater in the United States designed exclusively for puppet theater and the study of puppetry. New programming, such as Tiny Tot Tuesdays, has continued to expand the Puppet Co.'s audiences. Today, nearly 100,000 children, parents and teachers enjoy the Puppet Co.'s unique blend of artistry, entertainment and education.
