# Friend of Glen Echo Park Award Isiah Leggett, Montgomery County Executive

In November 2006, Isiah Leggett was elected Montgomery County Executive. Prior to this, Mr. Leggett chaired the Maryland Democratic Party (2002-2004) and served on the Montgomery County Council (1986-2002). He is the first African American to serve as County Executive and as a Councilmember. Throughout his career, County Executive Leggett has passionately supported the arts and humanities in Montgomery County. He has been a strong advocate for the restoration and revitalization of Glen Echo Park as one of the county's greatest arts and cultural resources. Each year, he honors local artists, scholars, and organizations with the prestigious County Executive's Awards for Arts and Humanities, and he and his wife, Catherine, have brought considerable attention to the vital role that the arts and humanities play in our lives.

# Organizational Achievement Award Washington Folk Festival Dwain Winters, Technical Director

Dwain Winters is a founding board member of the Glen Echo Park Partnership for Arts and Culture, a past president of the Folklore Society of Greater Washington, and a board member of the National Counsel for the Traditional Arts. Mr. Winters has served as technical director of the Washington Folk Festival for the last 26 years and as festival coordinator for more than 12 years. The Washington Folk Festival – the largest annual event at Glen Echo Park – celebrates the cultural diversity of the greater Washington area by presenting over 450 local performers and craft persons. Mr. Winters also donates his festival management talents nationally, serving as technical director to the American Folk Festival in Bangor, Maine, the Richmond Folk Festival in

Richmond, Virginia, and, for the last 19 years, the National Folk Festival in Washington, DC.

# Organizational Achievement Award Folklore Society of Greater Washington Mary Cliff, President

Mary Cliff is host of WAMU's *Traditions*, a folk music program known for its breadth of material and strong emphasis on artists and performances in the DC region. Prior to this, Ms. Cliff was with WETA for 35 years, producing and presenting classical music, news, public affairs, arts interviews, and folk music. She has won several WAMMIE (Washington Area Music Association) awards in the "most supportive of Washington music" category. Ms. Cliff is active in community arts and music organizations as a volunteer and board member. She currently serves as the president of the board of the Folklore Society of Greater Washington. Ms. Cliff has enjoyed Glen Echo Park for many years and recalls fondly the sounds of the wooden roller coaster and the thrill of the rides in the amusement park days.

# Master of Ceremonies Rob Bamberger, Host of WAMU's Hot Jazz Saturday Night

Rob Bamberger has been sharing his interest in jazz and popular music of the 1920s to 1940s since the premiere of Hot Jazz Saturday Night on WAMU (88.5 FM) in September 1980. He is the producer, host, and engineer, and he adamantly refuses to be coaxed away from WAMU on Saturday nights except for the most special of events and causes in which he believes, such as tonight's Gala to support the Glen Echo Park Partnership. He has annotated numerous CDs on a wide range of themes and for a variety of performers, and recently completed a study for the National Recording Preservation Board on recorded sound preservation in the United States. Weekdays, Mr. Bamberger is a senior policy analyst for the Congressional Research Service at the Library of Congress.

# Cokie Roberts, Journalist and Author

Cokie Roberts is a senior news analyst for National Public Radio (NPR) News, where she was the congressional correspondent for more than 10 years. In addition to her work for NPR, Ms. Roberts is a political commentator for ABC News. From 1996-2002, she and Sam Donaldson co-anchored ABC's *This Week* program. In her more than 40 years in broadcasting, she has won countless awards, including three Emmys. She has been inducted into the Broadcasting and Cable Hall of Fame, and the Library of Congress named her a "Living Legend," one of few Americans to have attained that honor. Ms. Roberts has written several best-selling books, including *We Are Our Mothers' Daughters, Founding Mothers*, and *Ladies of Liberty*.

Steve Roberts is the author of From Every End of this Earth and My Fathers' Houses. He and his wife, Cokie, coauthored the bestseller From This Day Forward and together they write a nationally syndicated newspaper column. Mr. Roberts has worked as a journalist for more than 40 years, and has held positions at U.S. News & World Report and The New York Times. He appears regularly as a political analyst on the ABC radio network and NPR. Since 1997, he has been the Shapiro Professor of Media and Public Affairs at George Washington University. Mr. Roberts has enjoyed many activities at Glen Echo Park over the years with his family, and he has written about the Park's visual arts programs in his regular Bethesda magazine column called "Hometown."
