BIOGRAPHIES

The Honorable Constance Morella

Ambassador Connie Morella represented Maryland's 8th congressional district in the United States House of Representatives from 1987 to 2003. She also served as United States Ambassador to the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development from 2003 to 2007. In 2010, she was appointed by President Obama to the American Battle Monuments Commission and currently serves on American University's faculty as an Ambassador in Residence for the Women in Politics Institute. Her awards and recognitions include induction into the Maryland Women's Hall of Fame, the Ron Brown Standards Leadership Award, Medal of the Legion of Merit from The Republic of Italy, and numerous public service awards and honorary doctorates. Throughout her career Ambassador Morella has been a strong supporter of the arts and of Glen Echo Park. During her tenure in the House of Representatives she was instrumental in obtaining federal funds for a major renovation of the Park. This multi-year project, which was completed 2010, has helped to revitalize the Park and ensure that it remains one the area's greatest cultural resources.

Congresswoman Donna F. Edwards

Congresswoman Donna F. Edwards represents Maryland's 4th Congressional District. Elected in 2008 as the first African American woman to represent Maryland in the U.S. House of Representatives, Congresswoman Edwards serves on the Committees of Transportation and Infrastructure, Science and Technology, and the Tom Lantos Human Rights Commission. She is a Member of the Congressional Black Caucus, the Progressive Caucus, and was recently chosen to co-chair the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee's "Red to Blue" task force. A graduate of Wake Forest University and the University of New Hampshire School of Law, she has lived in Prince George's County for more than 25 years and currently resides in Fort Washington. She is the proud mother of a son who recently graduated from university.

Suzan Jenkins is the Chief Executive Officer of the Arts and Humanities Council of Montgomery County. She was recognized as one of the “Top CEOs You Need To Know in 2009” by The Gazette of Politics and Business and featured in “Women Business Leaders of Maryland 2010.” She has over 20 years of experience spearheading organizational and programmatic development in the nonprofit arts and culture sector, including working with world renowned organizations such as the Rhythm and Blues Foundation, the Smithsonian Institution, and the Recording Industry Association of America. She has produced several recordings and was the Conceptual Producer of the Peabody Award winning series “Let the Good Times Roll,” produced for Public Radio International. Ms. Jenkins is a strategic thinker and team builder, and her career has been dedicated to encouraging creativity and scholarly excellence in arts and cultural organizations. For the past three years, Montgomery County arts and humanities organizations, including the Glen Echo Park Partnership, have been the beneficiaries of this singular dedication.

Waltz Time is an all-volunteer group of dancers who have produced the twice-monthly waltzes at Glen Echo Park since 1995. Waltz Time has generously donated all net proceeds of their dance events to the renovation of the Spanish Ballroom and the Bumper Car Pavilion, and to help continue the Park’s programs. Waltz Time’s popular series of Sunday afternoon waltzes features live music and includes a sprinkling of other dance styles, including hambo, shottische, tango, and swing. In 2008, Waltz Time provided a major contribution to help renovate the Ballroom Annex. The Annex opened in March 2009 and now serves as the Park’s newest venue for social dances, dance and movement classes, and other special events. In April 2011, Waltz Time hosted the 28th annual Viennese Waltz Ball, a special benefit event in support of the Partnership, complete with dance cards, refreshments, and a Grand March. Under the leadership of Tony Treston and Joan Koury, the Waltz Time Committee is dedicated to serving dancers and supporting the Partnership and Glen Echo Park for years to come.
