Catherine Leggett Friend of Glen Echo Park Award

Catherine Leggett's broad career has included roles as an attorney, a senior executive, a board member, and an active supporter of the arts and humanities. Ms. Leggett is currently senior vice president for human resources at ICMA-RC, a nonprofit, independent financial services corporation focused on providing retirement security for the public sector.

As "First Lady" of Montgomery County, Ms. Leggett has been a staunch supporter of Montgomery County's cultural community. Along with her husband, County Executive Ike Leggett, she has brought considerable attention to the vital role that the arts and humanities play in our lives. County Executive Leggett and Ms. Leggett honor local artists and scholars and organizations each year with the prestigious County Executive's Awards for Arts and Humanities, which recognize the achievements of the county's cultural community. They also raise funds and visibility for arts and humanities organizations through the Montgomery County Executive's Ball, which Ms. Leggett has co-chaired for the past several years.

Ms. Leggett is also a board member of the Montgomery County Hospice, chair of Maryland State Commission for Public Art, and a former board member of Young Audiences, Imagination Stage, the Maryland State Arts Council, and the Montgomery County Arts and Humanities Council. She received a J.D. and a B.A. in sociology and psychology from Howard University. She was named "Democrat of the Year" in 2007 and is a member of many professional organizations.

Photoworks

Organizational Achievement Award

Photoworks was established 40 years ago by "four young photographers...with little more than a shared passion for the daily work of seeing, shooting, and printing images of lasting beauty and artistic integrity." Currently directed by photographer and teacher Karen Keating, Photoworks offers a diverse combination of educational programs, gallery exhibitions, and community initiatives. With an outstanding faculty and an intimate learning environment that encourages creative dialogue, Photoworks is a resource for both amateur and professional photographers.

Through Ms. Keating's leadership, dedication, and vision, Photoworks has evolved into a remarkable institution. She is an integral member of the Washington, DC photography community as an outstanding arts educator, administrator, and fine art photographer. Ms. Keating first came to Photoworks at Glen Echo Park as a student in 1977, and she has been teaching courses there since 1984. She became director of Photoworks in 1986 and continues to lead the organization as it celebrates its 40th anniversary. She shares her passion for fine art photography by teaching beginning, intermediate, and advanced courses for adults and youth. In addition to her commitments at Photoworks, Ms. Keating has been a full-time photography teacher at The Field School, an independent high school in Washington, DC, since 1990.

Jack Rasmussen Honorary Chair

Jack Rasmussen is the director and curator of the American University Museum at the Katzen Arts Center. The 30,000 square foot museum includes a variety of gallery spaces for exhibition of exciting contemporary art from the nation's capital region and the world.

Mr. Rasmussen previously held executive director positions at di Rosa Preserve: Art & Nature, Maryland Art Place, and Rockville Arts Place.

His career began as a part-time curator at the National Gallery of Art and also included work as the assistant director of Washington Project for the Arts. He was the owner and director of Jack Rasmussen Gallery in Washington, DC. Mr. Rasmussen holds advanced degrees in painting, arts management, anthropology, and anthropological linguistics – all from American University.

Carol Trawick Presenter

Carol Trawick, president of the Jim and Carol Trawick Foundation and a former teacher and entrepreneur, is engaged in a range of philanthropic causes through her foundation and other avenues. Created in 2007, the foundation supports nonprofits in the arts and health and human services. It has awarded grants to more than 90 nonprofits in Montgomery County and also funds the annual Trawick Prize for Contemporary Art and the Painting Awards.

Always active in the arts, Mrs. Trawick serves as vice-chair of the Maryland State Arts Council and has served as board chair of numerous organizations, including the Glen Echo Park Partnership, the Strathmore Music Center, the Bethesda-Chevy Chase Chamber of Commerce, and the Bethesda Urban Partnership. She was a Leadership Montgomery 2004 Leader of the Year, the Gazette 2006 Business Leader of the Year, a 2010 Washingtonian of the Year, and Montgomery County Philanthropist of the Year 2010. In 2012, she was elected to the Montgomery County Business Hall of Fame.

Sam Abell

Presenter

Sam Abell's celebrated career has spanned over 40 years, including mostly long-term projects for magazines and books. In 1970, he began 30 years of work with *National Geographic*, for which he is best known. Dedicated to documentary photography, Mr. Abell has taken photographs and exhibited his work throughout the world, and he now lectures and teaches on an international basis.

Mr. Abell's work with authors includes two collaborations with Stephen Ambrose – on Lewis & Clark: Voyage of Discovery and The Mississippi: River of History – as well as working with author Leah Bendavid-Val to produce a retrospective of his life and work titled Sam Abell: The Photographic Life.

Holly Morris

Emcee

Holly Morris is an accomplished television news reporter, currently with the FOX5 local news channel. Three days a week she reports on local stories for FOX's morning news program, and two days per week she works on the station's "Pay it Forward" campaign where she shares stories of people in the Washington, DC area who are "doing great things, not because they want to get noticed, but just because the want to make the world a better place."

Ms. Morris's path to news was unconventional, having begun her career with a degree in civil and environmental engineering from Duke University. But being in the news business was her dream, and her journey took her from Steubenville, Ohio and Lexington, Kentucky to the nation's capital. During her reporting career, she was among the first crews at the Pentagon on 9/11, and she has flown with the Air Force Thunderbirds, among other adventures. She has received nine regional Emmy Awards – five for Best Live Reporting.
