The Honorable Chris Van Hollen, United States Senator

Senator Van Hollen proudly represents the State of Maryland in the United States Senate where he serves on the Appropriations, Banking, Budget and Environmental and Public Works Committees.

He has been a tireless advocate for everyday Marylanders throughout his time in public service and a national leader on a wide range of key issues, including education, environmental protection, campaign finance reform, and health care, as our representative in the U.S. Senate and, before that, as a Democratic leader in the House of Representatives and the Maryland State legislature.

Senator Van Hollen is also proud to have worked successfully across party lines to pass bipartisan legislation whenever possible on issues of common concern, including expanding medical research, protecting the Chesapeake Bay, fighting childhood cancer, and assisting families of children with disabilities.

The Senator's involvement with Glen Echo Park spans many years and has never wavered. As a Maryland State legislator and later as a U.S. Congressman, he advocated for capital funding and an appropriate partnership structure to sustain Glen Echo Park as a public amenity for our diverse community.

In the U.S. Senate, he has taken on the role of spearheading the implementation of a new operating agreement for the Park. He was also instrumental in helping to develop the updated agreement for the Park between the National Park Service and Montgomery County, MD - personally working with the Secretary of Interior to ensure that the arrangement was finalized.

Senator Van Hollen is without question a tireless advocate and true friend of Glen Echo Park.

Scholarship & Transportation Fund

At last year's Gala, we established the Scholarship & Transportation Fund to enable underserved children to participate in Glen Echo Park's programs, and this year we continue to raise money for this much-needed resource.

All contributions committed tonight to the fund will be used to assist school-age children who cannot afford fees for classes or camps at Glen Echo Park. These funds will also be used to cover transportation costs for schools/camps to arrange field trips to the Park.

The fund has already begun to meet the need for transportation to the Park from regional schools that do not have full funding available. This enables more students to attend our children's theater performances and environmental education programs. Resident organizations at the Park that offer field trip opportunities include Adventure Theatre MTC, the Puppet Co., and the Glen Echo Park Aquarium.

The fund also will provide scholarships to allow school-age children who cannot afford full tuition to register for classes or camps at the Park with our financial assistance. In the past, we had to turn away those who requested subsidies because we did not have funds available.

Your contribution this evening during the Fund-a-Need will help ensure that the Park's programs are accessible to as many children as possible!
